Five Day Treatment Protocol for MRSA

Step1

Ensure hair and body are wet



Step 2

Put Octenisan (wash) on damp/ clean washcloth



Step 3

All over body wash and leave for 1 minute before rinsing-on day 2+4 wash hair as well

Attention to:

Armpits

Stomach + groin area



Step 4

Rinse off thoroughly



Step 5

Dry with clean and dry towel

*Nasal cream (Bactroban) should be put onto the tip of your little finger and rubbed just inside both nostrils 3 times per day as prescribed by your doctor.

*Octenisan (wash) should be used as shown in the daily steps guide once daily

Following 5 days treatment, please discard any unused Octenisan (wash) and Bactroban (nasal cream).

**You may wish to continue using the wash for longer than the 5 daysyou should <u>not</u> use the nasal cream after the 5 day prescription.

On completion of the treatment further screening (swabs) will need to be undertaken by nurse/GP surgery.

- 1. The first "set" should be at least 2 days after completion of treatment.
- 2. The next and final "set" at 10 days after that.

Post treatment screening will be arranged by the GP surgery if you are being looked after by your local Doctor or Health Visitor/Midwife/Nurse and you are receiving this treatment at home.
