11	MK Medicines & Therapeutics Committee Update		
	 MK Medicines & Therapeutics Committee Update The group noted the following: SCPC Policy 47a – Treatments for erectile dysfunction. The urologists have advised that they will not be following this policy. This has been referred to the Prescribing Forum. GPs were advised to pass unsuitable requests back to the urologists to complete a priorities request. Mexilitine was added to the formulary for use in myotonia by the neurologists only. There is currently a supply problem with this. Sandocal 1000 – added to the formulary for hypocalcaemia post thyroidectomy. Usual maximum of 6 weeks. Not to be added to repeat screens. Sanatogen A-Z complete added to the formulary for use where a complete vitamin and mineral supplement is required. Entecavir / Tenofovir for hepatitis B added subject to provision of a shared care protocol. Fluticasone furoate (Avamys) – HC has requested further information on its place in therapy from ENT. Azathioprine Shared Care Guidelines were approved for use in gastroenterology. These will be placed on FormularyMK when the final versions are received.

	JC advised that HC is leaving at the end of March to take up a position as Chief Pharmacist with MKCHS. HC was thanked for her contribution to Medicines Management in MK over the last 12 years. JC also noted that the team had lost Laura Lucas and Louise Reynolds (Medicines Management Technicians). As a result the team would be reconfigured to align it with the new CCG structures.
